Policy Title: Educational Placement of Students

With Special Needs

Policy No. 6.06

RATIONALE: The Board recognizes that Connect Charter School's primary mandate is to develop exemplary teaching and learning practices to meet the needs of all learners.

POLICY: Connect Charter School provides a supportive, inclusive learning environment that accommodates individual learning needs and creates opportunities for each student to achieve success in support of the Board's commitment to inclusive education practices.

PRINCIPLES:

- 1. Educational placements shall be determined by the Principal and teacher(s) in consultation with the parents or guardians of students identified with special needs.
- Every effort will be made to accommodate the individual learning needs of students and to help each student experience success within the resource capacity of the school.
- Where a particular student's special needs would be better served through a specialized program in another school the student and family shall be counseled and referred accordingly.
- 4. The school may engage in a variety of diagnostic and clinical testing to help determine the nature of any learning challenges that may affect a student's success within the program. Such testing may be done through school personnel and/or the family may be referred to a professional outside of the school for testing and appropriate intervention. Written consent will be obtained from parents prior to any testing or assessments.
- 5. The Connect Charter School building and grounds will be barrier-free.
