- personal integrity;
- excellent communication skills;
- a proven ability to collaborate with staff, students, parents, and external agencies to establish clear goals and direction and create positive action plans;
- a commitment to inclusive approaches that celebrate diversity;
- demonstrated capacity to understand research informed practice and utilize data to enhance educational practice;
- excellent organizational skills;
- a commitment to utilize technology to support student learning;
